### Sweden:

• Third biggest country in EU – 450,000 km<sup>2</sup>/1574 km from north to south

Population: 9,6 million

• Unemployment rate, 25-75 years olds: 5,8%


under 25 years: 15,2 %

37% higher education among 25-64 year olds

## Malmö:

- Population: approx. 300 000 (third biggest city)
- Population from 177 different countries with 150 different languages (31% born elsewhere)
- 30% with higher education





#### **Preschool**



- For children from 1 5
- Support for families
- Open all year around

#### **Preschool class**




- For 6-year olds
- Preparation for compulsory school





#### **Compulsory school**

- 9 years of mandatory schooling
- Municipality-run or Independent
- Individual development plans







#### **Upper secondary school**

- 3 year
- Non-compulsory
- 18 national programmes;
  - 6 programmes preparatory for higher education
  - 12 vocational programmes
- 5 introductory programmes








#### **Municipal Adult Education**

- Adults over 20
- Non-compulsory
- Publicly funded
- Equivalent to compulsory or upper secondary school
- Swedish for all new adult immigrants







#### **Adult education:**

- Liberal Adult education
  - Folk high schools: www.folkhogskola.nu
  - Educational associations (study circles)
- Labour market training offered by the National Employment Service
- In-service training at the work place





#### **Higher Vocational Education**

- Post-secondary
- Education tailored to meet the needs of the labour market
- 1/3 workplace training


#### Universities and university colleges

- Basic level (3 years)
- Advanced level (1-2 years)
- Research level (2-4 years)
- Full-time academic year = 60 higher education credits
- State-run 50 universities and colleges
